With his success in building online and blended programs, Larry's focus will be to continue developing ExL's portfolio of programs that meet the career and personal needs of learners of all ages, with a mandate to strengthen UBC's contribution to society, industry and government.

**Before joining ExL, Larry** spent 23 years in software development, educational technology and online learning leadership roles at Harvard. He returned to Harvard in 2013 to develop a new online course model for the Extension School, where he continues as an adjunct professor teaching computer science.

Most recently, he was Senior Director of Digital Learning Initiatives at Brown University, where he led a team that supported a variety of online and blended programs. Larry is also a founder of the School of Graduate and Professional Studies at New England Institute of Technology. Under his leadership, NEIT's online bachelor program went from being unranked to eighth place nationally within three years.

His own early career experiences, including a stint as a sound engineer for rock bands, and a Harvard Extension School certificate program, sparked a lifelong interest in the transformational effects of continuing education for adult learners.

Larry holds a bachelor's degree in psychology from the University of Rhode Island and completed a software engineering program at Harvard. He is completing a Master of Science in Information Technology at the New England Institute of Technology.
