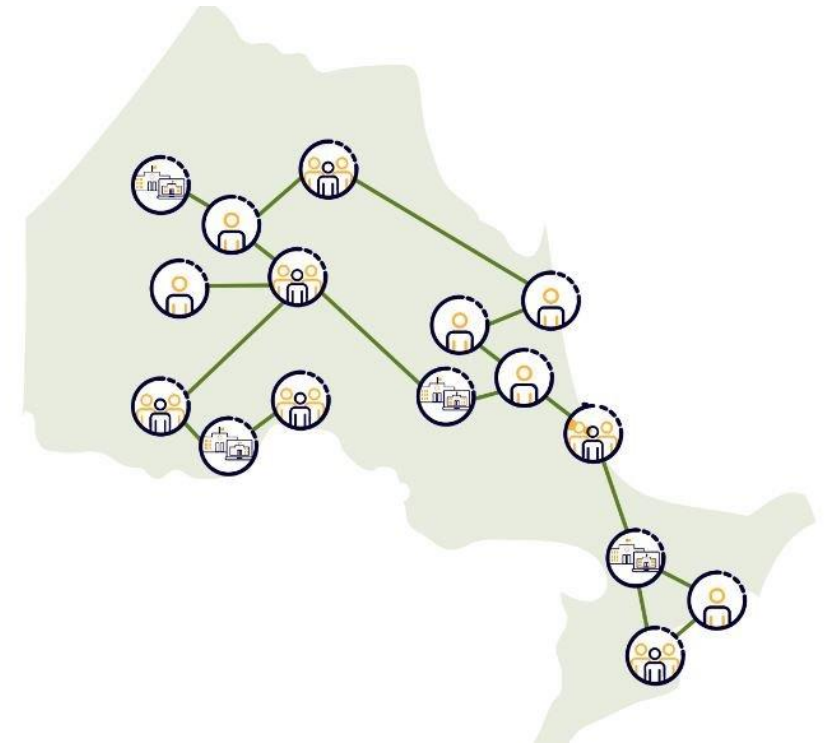



# Labour Market Information Integration

Administrators can tag courses and programs with:

- ✓ Related job titles, hiring trends, and occupational outlooks;
- ✓ Associated skills, tools, and technologies.

AI tools, leveraging machine learning, help administrators refine LMI tagged to listings.

LMI integration facilitates recommendations for upskilling and reskilling based on **job title, skills, tools, technologies, keywords, and industries.**
